

**ORDERED**, that the Status Conference previously scheduled for July 10, 2013, at 4:00 p.m., is rescheduled for **Thursday, July 25, 2013, at 10:00 a.m.**; and it is hereby

**ORDERED**, that Plaintiffs' Motion is **granted** insofar as the Status Conference will take place in open court and address "issues caused by Chartered's failure to reimburse EPSDT providers for services rendered to children in the Plaintiff class"; and it is hereby

**ORDERED**, that both parties shall submit any information related to those issues to the Court by **Monday, July 22, 2013, at 12:00 p.m.**
