

DO YOU GET MEDICAID?

If so, it may soon be time to renew your Medicaid coverage.

You should:

- Make sure that the D.C. government has your current address by calling (202) 727-5355 or creating a DC Health Link My Account at www.dchealthlink.com; AND
- Check your mail for a renewal form from the D.C. government.

You must return this form within 60 days after you get it or you will lose your Medicaid.

How do I return the form?

- Complete it online through your My Account using the renewal code on the renewal form.
- OR**
- Fill out the form and bring it to an Economic Security Administration (ESA) Service Center. Write down the date and time you submitted it and ask for proof.

What if I already missed the deadline?

- Go to an ESA Service Center right away to complete the renewal process.
- You only have 90 days from the deadline to renew to receive Medicaid coverage back to the date of termination. After 90 days, you must file a new application.

How do I get help with Medicaid renewal?
