**ORDER**

Upon consideration of Plaintiffs’ Motion to Enforce the Reimbursement Procedures Order of September, 15, 1997, it is this 18th day of February, 2014, hereby

**ORDERED**, that Defendants shall waive the six-month deadline for filing reimbursement claims for all Medicaid beneficiaries who state that they filed or attempted to file a reimbursement form, relying on the incorrect address for the Recipient Claims Research Team (RCRT), to extend the time for a beneficiary to submit a claim for reimbursement for out-of-pocket expenses from 180 days from the date of service to 270 days from the date of service, as long as the beneficiary does so by March 31, 2014; and it is further

**ORDERED**, that Defendants shall publicize this waiver of the six-month deadline through a press release on Defendants’ website.
